The History Department decided to become a sanctuary space for Saint Mary's students.

Statement from the Department:

Consistent with the Mission of the College to defend “the goodness, dignity and freedom of each person,” and animated by SOLA’s commitment to “work, together and as individuals, in solidarity with marginalized groups, to promote social justice and transform our world for the common good,” the Saint Mary’s Department of History hereby declares its offices to be off limits to Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) officials. Any member our community who feels endangered can find sanctuary within our offices, and be assured that we will not cooperate with any party that seeks to breach the security afforded by those spaces. Further, we encourage in the strongest of terms that the College formally designate itself a sanctuary campus. In the absence of such a designation, and should it be necessary, the history department pledges to resist the presence of ICE agents on College property, cooperation between campus public safety and federal immigration authorities, and sharing student information with immigration enforcement officials.
