School Description:

San Miguel High School is a Catholic, Lasallian learning community empowering youth from underserved families. San Miguel nurtures a Christian spirit and integrates rigorous academic with practical workplace experience, thereby transforming students to be prepared for college and career. San Miguel high school is sponsored by the Brothers of the Christian Schools (www.delasalle.org). The school opened in August 2004. San Miguel currently has approximately 350 students and expects to be at 400 in the 2019 – 2020 school year. (www.sanmiguelhigh.org)

All students are required to complete a college preparatory curriculum and participate in the internship program whereby they spend five days per month engaged in a professional work assignment. San Miguel High School is part of the Cristo Rey Network (www.cristoreynetwork.org), 33 high schools in the United States that subscribe to similar demographic, academic, and internship program guidelines.

The Corporate Work Study Program (CWSP) is a unique feature of the Cristo Rey model. The school includes a subsidiary employment agency which trains the students for entry-level employment and markets their services to local clients. Typically, four students share one full-time position from the beginning of August through May. The fees for the students' services go directly to the school to pay a significant portion of the cost of education.
