Preference will also be given to those with the ability to teach all science courses at the AP[®], honors, and college prep levels, who have a keen interest in incorporating appropriate innovative technologies, and who possess a current California Teaching Credential. We seek candidates with an active interest in developing courses with substantive interdisciplinary, experiential, and service components. We seek candidates with track records of positive, professional collaboration in team settings and with the desire and capacity to grow as an instructional leader. An understanding of the developmental needs of adolescents is necessary; therefore, we seek a healthy combination of positivity, flexibility, energy, creativity, and a sense of humor. We seek demonstrated experience working in a diverse, inclusive community and strong cross-cultural competency skills.
